

## Page 3 WATERFORD WORLD'S FAIR EXHIBITORS RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Move in times....Someone will be on the grounds to spot you starting at 10:00am, Thursday, 7/13. Security starts Thursday night, 7/13 at 9pm, All vendors need to be set up by 7pm Thursday
- 2. (3) one day gate passes will be included with each 10'x10' space.
- 3. All exhibitors shall be required to check in with the Vendor's Superintendent immediately upon arrival.
- 4. Booth spaces are in increments of 10'x10'. Bulk space is also available if needed.
- 5. Booths must be occupied during fair hours. Fair hours are 9am-8pm Friday and Saturday and 9am-5pm on Sunday. Gate opens at 7 am.
- 6. In order to control excessive repetition of exhibits, all merchandise must be listed.
  All items not listed will not be allowed unless given special permission by the
  Vendor's Superintendent.
- 7. All space is on a first come, first serve basis.

- 8. The exhibitor shall not sublet any space.
- 9. If the exhibitor fails to occupy his/her designated space by July 14th at 9:00am or notify Vendor Superintendent of a legitimate reason for tardiness, Waterford *World's Fair* may, at its option, offer the space to another exhibitor.
- 10. All exhibits are to stay in place until 5pm on Sunday, July 16, 2023.
- 11. No motorized vehicles are allowed in the exhibition area after 9am daily.

  Emergency vehicles are the only exception. All vehicles, not part of the exhibit must be parked in designated areas.
- 12. All UPS/freight deliveries must be met at the front gate.
- 13. Any exhibitor found in possession of anything illegal will be asked to leave the grounds immediately.
- 14. All property brought upon the *Waterford World's Fair* grounds shall be the sole responsibility of the owner, and *Waterford World's Fair Association* assumes no responsibility for its safety.
- 15. Exhibitors shall keep their space(s) clean and free of safety hazards.
